Instructions to Coaches
Volleyball

DYA coaches have several responsibilities during the season, including the following:

Leadership and control of their teams

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their teams. The team definition includes the players, the coaches, and their fans. In all DYA games any player or coach ejected or disqualified is subject to suspension from participation for a minimum of one game, not including the game in which the ejection occurred. Any fan ejected from any DYA game is prohibited from attending a minimum of one game, not including the game in which the ejection occurred. No more than two coaches, one head and one assistant, may sit on the team bench during games.

Distribution of playing time

Coaches are encouraged to develop all players, providing each an opportunity to play during the season.

Providing volleyball for games and practices; Equipment Return and Evaluations

Each coach receives five game balls and a ball bag for his/her team's use during the season. It is the coach's responsibility to return these items at season's end. A deposit check of \$100 payable to DYA is required and will be returned at season's end when equipment is returned in tact. Each coach must turn in four balls with the bag and may keep one ball. Equipment will be turned in at the school after the last game. The evaluation form must also accompany equipment to receive the deposit check.

Communicating practice and game schedule changes

During the season if schools are closed for any reason, there is no practice. If you arrive at a school and there is a school function, please leave quietly, then call your commissioner. There are unexpected conflicts from time-to-time and the schools have first priority in the use of the gym. Every effort will be made to get your team a make-up practice.

If schools are closed on Friday, there may still be games on Saturday. Game cancellations will be announced on the web site www.dya.com or on 777-2222 x 7246. Every effort will be made to make the announcements on a timely basis. Canceled games, if any, will not be made up.

Payment to Referees

Coaches in leagues for grades 5 through 12 are responsible for distributing payments to referees. Each head coach receives cash at the coaches' meeting which is to pay officials throughout the year.

Each head coach receives \$48 for the season.

Regular Season for Grades 5-12

During the regular season each coach will pay the DYA referee \$6.00. Thus, each week coaches pay referees a total of \$12.00. *Payment is made prior to the start of the game.*

Tournament Play for Grades 7-12

During the post-season tournaments, each coach pay the referee \$6.00 for the first game. The league will be responsible for paying referees for subsequent games.
